H1N1 Vaccination Clinic Schedule for November 24, 2009 - December 18, 2009

NasalFlu Mist vaccine will be administered unless specific illnesses or conditions prevent its use

Injections will ONLY be given to those who cannot take the flu mist nasal spray

TARGET GROUPS: Pregnant women; Persons living with or providing care for infants less than 6 months of age (e.g. parents, siblings, and daycare providers); Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel; Persons aged 6 months to 24 years; Persons ages 25-64 who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications

- * Anyone 65 or older will NOT be vaccinated unless they are a direct caregiver of a child six months of age or younger.**
- * All minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Legal guardians must provide proof of guardianship.**
- * Persons seeking the vaccine will need to bring photo identification and insurance card, if they have insurance. The vaccine is free, however, those persons with coverage may have their insurance billed a fee for administration of the vaccine. Those without insurance will not be charged the administration fee.**
